Thank you for all your support as we have navigated the Spring Term with some changes to staff and classes. Please be assured that any decisions we make about supporting pupils and the curriculum are made with the best interests of our students at the forefront.

GCSE Mock Exams – February

Year 11 pupils should have used the feedback from their last round of mock exams to direct their revision over the over the Christmas holiday and over February half term. The timetable has been published to the portal for your daughter to refer to when planning her revision schedule. Mrs Spencer and I have met with Year 11 to reiterate the JCQ Regulations and to reassure and prepare pupils for their last round of mock exams. Pupils must bring an exam pencil case with black ball point pens, a ruler, pencil, eraser and a calculator (if required for the exam). Please ensure that you daughter has the correct equipment in advance of the exams.

Assembly themes

Achievement Assembly and Themed Assembly will now be held on Friday morning for the whole school. This term we have explored the theme of change and why change can be good for us. Other themes for this term are: Holocaust Memorial Day (for Year 6 and above), Burns Night and how it is celebrated; National Story Telling Week and how love always overcomes negativity. Pupils will be awarded certificates and postcards in our Friday assembly so please do look inside your child's bag so that you can celebrate their achievements with them.

PE news
